

RESOLUTION R 3222

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
IN SUPPORT OF THE COUNTY-WIDE 1985 KING COUNTY MEDIC  
ONE/EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY.

Whereas, the King County Medic One Program is a high  
quality program which delivers life-saving emergency medi-  
cal care to all citizens of King County and provides for  
their health and safety; and

Whereas, emergency medical services are essential and  
should be afforded a stable funding base; and

Whereas, in order to assure the continued provision of  
these services from 1986-1991, it is both necessary and  
appropriate that a property tax of \$.25 per \$1,000 of  
assessed valuation be levied each year for six years, all  
as provided for in King County Ordinance 7343; and


Whereas, the previous six-year levy supporting emer-  
gency medical services in King County expires on  
December 31, 1985; and

Whereas, this proposed resolution came before the  
Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting on  
October 21, 1985 and before voting thereon, the City  
Council did allow all persons then in attendance to  
express their views on this resolution and the subject  
matter of said ballot proposition, now, therefore,


Be it resolved that the City Council of the City of

November 5, 1985 general election ballot.
