

RESOLUTION R-3327

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REFERRING TO THE KIRKLAND HEARING EXAMINER, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 3.34.030(4) KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE, THE LAND USE MATTER IDENTIFIED AS DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. III-IV-86-101.

WHEREAS, subsection 3.34.030.(4) of the Kirkland Municipal Code provides that the Kirkland Hearing Examiner shall have:

"(4) Such other authorities and responsibilities as the City Council, from time to time, shall specifically grant to the Hearing Examiner."; and

WHEREAS, the City Council with the concurrence of the Kirkland Planning Commission believes that the hereinafter designated land use matter should be referred to the Hearing Examiner rather than coming before the Planning Commission; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. That certain land use matter identified as Department of Planning and Community Development File No. III-IV-86-101, being an application for an office in the Freeway Commercial II zone, and an amendment to the text of the Zoning Code to increase the maximum permitted height for an office use in the FC II zone as filed by Costco Wholesale Corporation, applicant, which normally would go before the Kirkland Planning Commission for recommendation to the Kirkland City Council, is hereby referred, pursuant to subsection 3.34.030(4) of the Kirkland Municipal Code, to the Kirkland Hearing Examiner in accordance with Process IIB as established in Chapter 152 of the Zoning Ordinance, which said Process provides that the decision of the Hearing Examiner shall be a recommendation to the City Council.
