

RESOLUTION NO. R-3341

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND IN SUPPORT OF INCREASING THE STATE GAS TAX.

WHEREAS, revenue available to address the City of Kirkland's traffic problems are not sufficient; and

WHEREAS, traffic related problems continue to grow as a result of increased development in the City and in surrounding jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the development community is paying for its share of the growth impacts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. To support an increase in state taxes imposed on gasoline for the purpose of addressing traffic problems associated with urban growth.
