RESOLUTION R-3363

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RENAMING LAKE STREET LANDING PARK, LOCATED AT 700 LAKE STREET SOUTH, TO DAVID E. BRINK PARK.

Whereas, David E. Brink served as Kirkland Director of Parks and Recreation for at least 15 years prior to his death in 1985; and

Whereas, the vision, ingenuity and enthusiasm of <u>David E. Brink</u> were central forces in the efforts of the City of Kirkland to expand the Kirkland park system, including the acquisition and development of Kirkland waterfront parks from Juanita Bay to Houghton Beach; and

Whereas, Resolution R3215 sets forth policies and procedures relating to the naming of public park property and facilities based upon several criteria, including naming after an individual who has given outstanding civic service to the park system, or who has been instrumental in the acquisition or development of critical park acreage; and

Whereas, the Kirkland Park Board has recommended to the Kirkland City Council the renaming of Lake Street Landing Park to David E. Brink Park in honor of his commitment to the acquisition and development of waterfront parks for which Kirkland is so well known; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the recommendation of the Kirkland Park Board meets the criteria established by Resolution R3215 and that renaming Lake Street Landing Park located at 700 Lake Street South to David E. BrinkPark is an appropriate way for the City of Kirkland to honor the contributions and efforts of David E. Brink while serving as Parks and Recreation Director for the City of Kirkland; now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. That certain waterfront park now known as Lake Street Landing Park containing 485 feet of shoreline, open lawn areas, dock, park benches, walkways and viewing vista which is located at 700 Lake Street South is hereby renamed David E. Brink Park in honor of Kirkland's former Parks and Recreation Director.

Section 2. The Department of Parks and Recreation is directed, pursuant to Resolution R3215, to install signs on the Park site identifying the new name of the Park.
