

RESOLUTION R-3375

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE KIRKLAND CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND THAT CERTAIN SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR THE AREA OF KING COUNTY LYING EASTERLY OF LAKE WASHINGTON.

Whereas, King County, the cities of Bellevue, Redmond, Kirkland, Bothell and Issaquah, the municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, the Washington State Department of Transportation and the Puget Sound Council of Governments have heretofore entered into an Interlocal Agreement to undertake the development of a multi-jurisdictional transportation program for the area commonly known as "the East Side"; and

Whereas, in order for the Washington State Department of Transportation to fully participate in said program, certain additions are required to be made to the Interlocal Agreement by way of a document identified as "Supplement No. 1"; now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager for the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain Supplement No. 1 (attached to the original of this Resolution) as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein) to the Interlocal Governmental Agreement heretofore approved by the City of Kirkland by Resolution R3353 adopted February 17, 1987.

Section 2. The Deputy City Clerk for the City of Kirkland is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the City of Redmond as lead agency under the Interlocal Agreement.
