

RESOLUTION NO. R 3396 A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND EXPANDING THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE LOWER JUANITA, NORTH ROSE HILL AND SOUTH ROSE HILL ANNEXATION ADVISORY COMMITTEES

WHEREAS, on October 20, 1986, the Kirkland City Council passed Resolution 3320 establishing three citizen committees to study the potential annexation areas of Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill and South Rose Hill; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 3320 established that the purpose of these committees was to:

- a. Identify, through public discussion, the major issues that the City should address prior to an annexation action;
- b. Serve as a center for public questions about the mechanics of annexation;
- c. Provide to the Planning Commission and City Council an evaluation and recommendations regarding major annexation issues; and

WHEREAS, the committees have accomplished the mission established by Resolution 3320 and made their reports, together with recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council; and

WHEREAS, each of the committees have expressed interest in disseminating the information that they have gathered to residents in the annexation areas; and

WHEREAS, the Committees have formally requested that the City Council expand their mission to include one neighborhood meeting in each annexation area at the end of September (see Attachment 1);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill and South Rose Hill Annexation Advisory Committees are authorized to hold one neighborhood meeting in late September in their respective annexation areas. In conducting these meetings, the committees will be acting as official committees of the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. The sole purpose of the neighborhood meetings shall be to disseminate information gathered during the course of the committees' study. Committee members shall not use these meetings to advocate for or against annexation.

Section 3. The Committees are authorized to conduct any reasonable preparation or follow-up to these meetings. However, the Committees shall dissolve as official committees of the City of Kirkland no later than October 9, 1987.
