RESOLUTION NO. R-3397 A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REGARDING THE MAINTE-NANCE OF THE JUANITA ENTRY SIGNS LOCATED IN LOWER JUANITA

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council heretofore by Resolution 3320 created annexation advisory committees for the three areas known as Lower Juanita. North Rose Hill and South Rose Hill; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 3320 defined one purpose of the annexation advisory committees as providing to the Planning Commission and City Council an evaluation and recommendations regarding major annexation issues; and

WHEREAS, in their June 11 report to the City Council, the Lower Juanita Committee identified the Juanita entry signs as an important asset in neighborhood identification; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland consists of a variety of neighborhoods, each with its own district history, character, and identity, and

WHEREAS, the preservation of this neighborhood identity contributes to the quality of life within the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland recognizes that the Juanita entry signs serve this important identity function;

NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. It is the policy of the present City Council that, in the event that Lower Juanita votes to annex to the City of Kirkland at the November 3, 1987 general election, the City agrees to the following:

- The two Juanita entry signs located in Lower Juanita will be maintained at their current location, and
- The City agrees to assume responsibility for maintaining, including b. landscaping and repairing, the two Juanita entry signs in Lower Juanita.

Section 2. A copy of this resolution shall be distributed to all members of the Lower Juanita Committee and the Juanita Business Association.
