

RESOLUTION NO. R-3403

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S INTENT TO COMPLETE AN INVENTORY OF CAPITAL NEEDS IN LOWER JUANITA, NORTH ROSE HILL, AND SOUTH ROSE HILL, IF ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1987, the three citizen annexation advisory committees for the Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill, and South Rose Hill potential annexation areas provided the City Council with final reports on services and infrastructure for each of their respective areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that each of these potential annexation areas may be deficient in certain capital facilities, including street improvements and parks; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels that capital needs in each of these areas, if annexed, should be fully inventoried; and

WHEREAS, any specific capital proposals for the potential annexation areas, if annexed, would be considered as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, following annexation, as a part of the 1989 Capital Improvement Program planning process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council establishes the intent of the City to complete a thorough inventory of all capital needs within the Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill, and South Rose Hill areas, if these areas annex to the City. This inventory may be used as the basis for developing capital improvement proposals as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program.

Section 2. Prior to annexation and the inventory of capital needs, the City Council directs staff of the Department of Planning and Community Development to keep a file record of all capital proposals or issues identified in each of the potential annexation areas.
