A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S INTENT TO REVIEW ORDINANCE NO. 3032 TWO YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, on June 29, 1987, the City Council studied the question of liberalizing the City's gambling ordinance to permit punchboards, pull tabs, and card rooms; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1987, the City Council received recommendations from the Lower Juanita, South Rose Hill, and North Rose Hill annexation advisory committees to permit punchboards, pull tabs, and card rooms in the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the North Rose Hill Committee also recommended that the City review this decision in the future and reinstate the prohibition on punch boards, pull tabs, and card rooms, if these activities resulted in police enforcement or other problems; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on August 3, 1987, did adopt Ordinance No. $\underline{3032}$ permitting punch boards, pull tabs, and card rooms in the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to insure that the adoption of Ordinance No. 3032 does not create any police enforcement or other related problems,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Two years from the effective date of Ordinance No. $\underline{3032}$, or no later than August, 1989, the City Council will review the effects of this ordinance. This review shall include an examination of police enforcement activities and any other related issues.

Section 2. If, through this review, the City Council determines that the activities of punch boards, pull tabs, and card rooms in the City of Kirkland is not in the public interest, the City Council may reinstate the prohibition on these activities.
