

RESOLUTION R -3416

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATING, PURSUANT TO RCW 29.81A.080, COMMITTEES TO PREPARE FOR INCLUSION IN THE KING COUNTY LOCAL VOTERS PAMPHLET, ARGUMENTS ADVOCATING APPROVAL AND DISAPPROVAL OF THE SOUTH ROSE HILL, NORTH ROSE HILL, AND LOWER JUANITA ANNEXATION PROPOSALS, APPEARING ON THE NOVEMBER 3, 1987 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

Whereas, King County will publish and distribute a local voters pamphlet for the November 3, 1987 General Election within King County, pursuant to RCW 29.81A; and

Whereas, RCW 29.81A.080 requires the legislative body of the jurisdiction placing a proposal on the ballot, to appoint "persons known to favor the measure to serve on the committee advocating approval and to appoint persons known to oppose the measure to serve on the committee advocating rejection" to prepare the arguments appearing in the local voters pamphlet as to such measures, now, therefore

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The following persons are named as the committee to prepare, for inclusion in the King County local voters pamphlet, arguments for approval of the following ballot propositions: Annexation to Kirkland of the area commonly known as South Rose Hill; annexation to Kirkland of the area commonly known as North Rose Hill; annexation to Kirkland of the area commonly known as Lower Juanita: Roger Salisbury, Michael Radcliff, and Sally Hansen.

Section 2. The following persons are named as the committee to prepare, for inclusion in the King County local voters pamphlet, arguments for disapproval of the following ballot propositions: Annexation to Kirkland of the area known as South Rose Hill; annexation to Kirkland of the area commonly known as North Rose Hill; annexation to Kirkland of the area commonly known as Lower Juanita: Merlin Lane, Arne Hartvigson, and Charles (Chuck) Trapp.
