

RESOLUTION R - 3427

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO APPOINT ONE RESIDENT FROM EACH OF THE LOWER JUANITA, NORTH ROSE HILL, AND SOUTH ROSE HILL ANNEXATION AREAS TO MEMBERSHIP ON THE KIRKLAND PARK BOARD, FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THEIR RESPECTIVE ANNEXATIONS TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

Whereas, the voters of the "annexation areas" commonly known as Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill, and South Rose Hill have voted to annex to the City of Kirkland, and

Whereas, said annexations are anticipated to become effective as of January 1, 1988, and

Whereas, the City Council believes that it is in the best interest of the City to provide representation from each of the three annexation areas on the Kirkland Park Board for a limited period of time, and

Whereas, as of January 1, 1988, or shortly thereafter, there will be three vacancies on the Kirkland Park Board, now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Kirkland City Council hereby declares its intention to appoint to the Park Board when filling the three vacancies thereon anticipated to occur as of January 1, 1988, or shortly thereafter, one resident from each of the three annexation areas, to wit: Lower Juanita, North Rose Hill, and South Rose Hill.

Section 2. Nothing in this resolution shall be deemed or taken as establishing a policy of neighborhood or regional representation on the Park Board, other than with respect to the three vacancies specifically referred to in this Resolution, and all appointments to the Park Board thereafter shall be made consistent with the City Council's longstanding policy to appoint the best possible persons from throughout the entire City as a whole.
