

RESOLUTION R-3464

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PROCEDURES FOR MANAGEMENT OF THE MARINA PARK BOAT LAUNCH.

Whereas, the City Council requested that the Park Board develop recommendations to improve Marina Park boat launch operations, and

Whereas, the Park Board recommends that the City implement a controlled gate system at the boat launch, improve signage and roadway markings and post Lake Avenue West closed to boat trailer parking, and

Whereas, the City Council has reviewed the proposals and finds that they merit adoption or further consideration, now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. A control gate shall be purchased and installed at the Marina Park boat launch by July 31, 1988, to be placed into operation no earlier than April 1, 1989. A fee shall be charged for access to the boat launch from April 1 to October 31, annually, beginning in 1989, the amount of which fee will be set prior to April 1, 1989. Only loading of boats shall be allowed after 3:00 p.m. each Seafair race day after 1988. Signage and pavement markings shall be redesigned to enhance public safety and convenience by improving traffic circulation and awareness of proper use procedures. "No Boat Trailer Parking" signs shall be posted to eliminate boat trailer parking in the public right-of-way of Lake Avenue West.

Section 2. Each year beginning in 1989, only boats 24 feet in length or less shall be launched or loaded at the Marina Park boat launch from April 1 to October 31. Prior to the completion of the Waverly Site Master Plan, informal, temporary car and boat trailer parking shall continue to be permitted on the Waverly site, only at the south lot.

Section 3. The Council will give further consideration to recommendations that: hours of boat launch operation be limited to 5:30 a.m. through 10:00 p.m.; the gate and fee system be evaluated at least yearly; closure of the boat launch be considered within five years; and the shortage of boat launch facilities be addressed with other jurisdictions.
