

## RESOLUTION NO. R-3516

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND URGING KING COUNTY TO DISCONTINUE IMPOSITION OF THE SOLID WASTE DUMPING FEE SURCHARGE.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Kirkland are paying a surcharge on the solid waste dumping fee, and

WHEREAS, said surcharge was imposed by King County for the principal purpose of funding a solid waste incinerator, and

WHEREAS, King County has determined that it will not proceed in the foreseeable future with the building of a solid waste incinerator, and

WHEREAS, the draft Environmental Impact Statement for the King County Solid Waste Disposal Comprehensive Plan anticipates that methods other than incineration will be utilized for the disposal of the solid waste stream,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland urges King County and the King County Council to eliminate the solid waste dumping fee surcharge imposed and collected by King County for the purpose of funding, including capital construction, of a solid waste or garbage incinerator.

Section 2. The Kirkland City Council further requests the King County Council refund the solid waste dumping fee surcharge already collected by King County and earmarked for planning, siting, design and construction of solid waste or garbage incinerators.
