

RESOLUTION NO. R-3530

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR AN OUTDOOR RECREATION PROJECT TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION AS PROVIDED BY THE MARINE RECREATION LAND ACT - RENOVATION OF THE RECREATIONAL BOAT MOORAGE DOCK AT MARINA PARK.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland has approved a "Comprehensive Park Open Space and Recreation Plan" for the City which identifies renovation of the Marina Park recreational transient boat moorage facility at Marina Park on the eastern shore of Lake Washington in Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland considers it in the best public interest to renovate the Marina Park recreational transient moorage facility located in the western part of the City along the east shore of Lake Washington at the foot of Kirkland Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington;

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make ~~formal~~ application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding assistance.

Section 2. Any fund assistance so received shall be used in the renovation of the recreational transient boat moorage facilities in Marina Park on the eastern shore of Lake Washington within the City of Kirkland.

Section 3. The City's share of the project will be derived from City reserve funds.

Section 4. The City of Kirkland does hereby certify that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize.

Section 5. Any property acquired with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation will be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility

and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.

Section 6. This resolution shall become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

Section 7. Adequate notification has been given, an opportunity provided for public input, and that published notices have identified affected flood plains and/or wetlands, if applicable.

Section 8. The City of Kirkland hereby certifies that the City is owner of the land to be developed and based on current knowledge, provides assurance there are no encumbrances on the land which would restrict recreation use of the land as proposed in this application.
