Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland as governing authority of said City hereby requests extension of the boundaries on the King County Conservation District to include all of the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain "Petition for Inclusion of Additional Territory Within the King County Conservation District", addressed to the Washington State Conservation Commission. A copy of said Petition is attached to the original of this Resolution and by this reference incorporated herein.




