

RESOLUTION R-3550

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
ADOPTING A TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

Whereas, commuter traffic congestion is a serious problem within the City of Kirkland, as well as the entire Metropolitan Seattle Area, and

Whereas, the City of Kirkland is a major employer within the City of Kirkland, and

Whereas, inadequate parking space exists at City Hall to accommodate the number of City employees attempting to use such space and to also accommodate citizens and visitors conducting business at City Hall, and

Whereas, the City Council desires to establish a transportation and parking incentive program, including incentive payments to City employees using car pools, van pools, transit and other non-single occupancy motor vehicle means of transportation to and from work, now therefore

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: There is hereby adopted a City of Kirkland Employee Transportation Program as set forth in Attachments A through D, inclusive, to this Resolution and which by this reference are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to immediately take all steps necessary and required to establish and maintain said Employee Transportation Program, including employee incentives as provided therein. The City Manager shall further make periodic reports to the City Council concerning the operation of the transportation program.
