

RESOLUTION NO. R-3589

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR HOUSE BILL 2568 AND SENATE BILL 6412 RELATING TO THE FUNDING OF WILDLIFE HABITAT AND OUTDOOR RECREATION PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate of the State of Washington have proposed legislation to provide a regular funding source for wildlife habitat conservation as well as outdoor recreation programs, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has a long history of participation in state programs designed to enhance and develop local opportunities for outdoor recreation, and



BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


