

RESOLUTION NO. R-3605

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR AN OUTDOOR RECREATION PROJECT TO THE WASHINGTON STATE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION AND THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AQUATIC LANDS ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT, AS PROVIDED BY THE MARINE RECREATION LAND ACT - JUANITA BAY PARK DEVELOPMENT.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Kirkland has approved a "five year capital improvement program" for the City which identifies the Juanita Bay Park Development Project on the eastern shore of Lake Washington in Kirkland; and

Whereas, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Kirkland considers it in the best public interest to develop Juanita Bay, located in the northern part of the City along the east shore of Lake Washington and the southeastern shore of Juanita Bay, as a possible nature park; now, therefore

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington, that

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and to the Washington State Department of Natural Resources, Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account, for funding assistance.

Section 2. Any fund assistance so received shall be used in the development of Juanita Bay Park on the eastern shore of Lake Washington within the City of Kirkland as a passive nature park.

Section 3. The City's share of the project will be derived from the 1989 Kirkland Centennial Park Bond.

Section 4. The City of Kirkland does hereby certify that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize.

Section 5. Any property acquired with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation

and through the Washington State Department of Natural Resources, Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account, will be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.


Section 6. This resolution shall become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and the Washington State Department of Natural Resources, Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account.

Section 7. Adequate notification has been given, an opportunity provided for public input, and published notices have identified affected flood plains and/or wetlands, if applicable.

Section 8. The City of Kirkland hereby certifies that the City is owner of the land to be developed and based on current knowledge, provides assurance that there are no encumbrances on the land which would restrict recreation use of the land as proposed in this application.


