°A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND EXPRESSING AN INTENT TO RELINQUISH ANY INTEREST IN A PORTION OF THIRD AVENUE SOUTH.

Whereas, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land or sewer line which currently runs under a portion of Third Avenue South once the adjoining property owner installs a new sewer line at the southern end of the property; and

Whereas, the City of Kirkland was incorporated as a municipal corporation in 1905; and

Whereas, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32 provides that any county road which remains unopended for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

Whereas, in this context it is in the public interest for the City Council to relinquish any interest which the City has in that unopended portion of Third Avenue South, between Lake Street South and Second Street South, now, therefore.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland will relinquish, by resolution, any interest in that unopened portion of Third Avenue South, between Lake Street South and Second Street South, and will acknowledge that title to said vacated portion of Third Avenue South should be quieted in the abutting property owners if within two years of the date of passage of this resolution the City has accepted an easement and the installation of a new sewer main to replace the current sewer line under Third Street South, between Lake Street South and Second Street South.
