

**RESOLUTION NO. R- 3642****A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF NE 58th Street (FILE NO VC-90-138)**

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of NE 58th Street.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of NE 58th Street

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of NE 58th Street, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows

The subject property is a triangular-shaped portion of NE 58th Street lying along the west 135 89 feet of the south boundary of Lot 6, Block 3, Burke & Farrar's Addition to the City of Seattle Division No. 7, and adjacent to the east of the south 10 feet of the east boundary of Lot 1, Finkbeiner Addition to Kirkland.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING.**

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on January 15, 1991, at 7 30 p m
