

RESOLUTION R- 3645

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND THAT CERTAIN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE CHILDREN'S FIRE SAFETY HOUSE CONSORTIUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF FIRE PREVENTION EDUCATION

Whereas, improving the quality of fire prevention education services is a legitimate function of fire protection agencies, and

Whereas, the cities and fire districts located east of Lake Washington in King County, intend to establish as a fire protection education program a consortium which will utilize a children's fire safety house as an educational tool, and

Whereas, each of said cities and fire districts is authorized to enter into such an agreement pursuant to RCW Chapter 39.34, now, therefore

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager for the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain Interlocal Agreement for Children's Fire Safety House in the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and by this reference incorporated herein. The agencies entering into said Agreement are the Cities of Bothell, Renton, Mercer Island, Kirkland, Redmond, Bellevue, Issaquah and King County Fire Districts 41, 34, 14 4, 10, 16, 25, 36 and 45, with the lead agency being King County Fire District 10.
