RESOLUTION R- 3746

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST
IN THIRD PLACE SOUTH.

Whereas, the City has received a
request to permanently abandon any rights
to land originally dedicated as a right-of-
way in Curtis' Addition to Kirkland in
1890; and

Whereas, the City of Kirkland was
incorporated as a municipal corporation in
1905; and

Whereas, the laws of 1889, Chapter 19,
Section 32 provides that any county road
which remains unopened for five years after
authority is granted for opening the same
is vacated; and

Whereas, in this context, it is in the
public interest to resolve this matter by
agreement;

Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the
City Council of the City of Kirkland as
follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the
City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes any
interest in the portion of right-of-way
dedicated as Third Place South (Valentine
Street) in the plat of Curtis' Addition to
Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, page 46,
records of King County, which abuts Blocks
5 and 6 of said plat, and acknowledges that
title to said vacated portions of rights-
of-way should not be vested in the City of
Kirkland.

Passed by majority vote of the
Kirkland City Council in regular, open
meeting this 2nd day of June, 1992.


