

RESOLUTION NO 3756

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
KIRKLAND URGING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO STUDY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SR 520
CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, a regional transit plan is currently being prepared to resolve transportation issues affecting the Eastside, and


WHEREAS, congestion and insufficient capacity on the SR 520 corridor remains as one of the major transportation problems facing Eastside residents, now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows

Section 1 The City Council and the City of Kirkland urges the State Department of Transportation to study improvements to the SR 520 corridor between I-5 and the I-405, including but not limited to high occupancy vehicle improvements, bicycle improvements, and institution of tolls
