#### **RESOLUTION R-3770**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT TO AMEND PROVISIONS OF THE EXISTING CONTRACT FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION BETWEEN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND SNO-KING DISPOSAL COMPANY, INC

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has amended its solid waste stream reduction and recycling plan to include a voluntary recycling program for multifamily residential customers within the City, and

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate said plan it is necessary to make certain amendments to the existing contract between the City of Kirkland and Sno-King Disposal Company, Inc. its solid waste collection Contractor, and

WHEREAS, said amendments are set forth in that certain agreement attached to the original of this Resolution as Exhibit A

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows

Section 1 The City Manager of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland the agreement to amend the existing contract between the City of Kirkland and Sno-King Disposal Company, Inc having a term commencing January 1, 1990 and ending December 31, 1997, substantially in the form set forth in Exhibit A attached to the original of this Resolution and by this reference incorporated herein The effective date for said amendments to be January 1, 1993

# CONTRACT AMENDMENT: CITY OF KIRKLAND WASTE MANAGEMENT - SNO-KING, INC.

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1992 between the City of Kirkland and Waste Management - Sno-King, Inc. to amend certain provisions of that certain contract between said parties dated January 1, 1990:

In consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreements contained herein, it is agreed that the following sections and subsections of that certain agreement dated January 1, 1990 between the City of Kirkland and Waste Management - Sno-King, Inc. are amended to read as follows:

Section 2.8 <u>Collection Schedules</u>. No collection shall be made except within the following time schedules:

For commercial and industrial: Between the hours of 5 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. (Where special circumstances or complaints received by the City indicate the necessity or desirability of an adjustment or change in the hours of collection or the days upon which collections may be made, then the City may require such an adjustment, including Saturday pick up, to be made upon written notice given to the Contractor.)

For residential dwellings: Between the hours of 6 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

For mixed commercial and residential usage at same location: Between the hours of 6 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Section. 2.31.4 Multi-Family Residential Recycling.
Multi-Family residential customers may choose and by the
City are urged to choose to participate in separation and
placement for collection for recycling the following
materials: Newspapers, mixed papers and recyclable bottles,
cans and plastic containers. Recyclable materials placed
for collection in bins will be collected by the Contractor
on the same pick up schedule as solid waste collections.
Recyclable materials shall be separated and placed in
recycling bins or carts distributed by the Contractor.
Multi-family residential customers using garbage can
collection service will receive three recycling bins for
recyclable materials per residential unit. Multi-family
residential customers using containers will receive two or

more recycling carts as d termined by the size of the solid waste container:

1. MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING SERVICES: The Contractor agrees to provide recycling services to all multi-family customers requesting the recycling services. The city shall compensate the contractor for these services according to the following schedule.

Standard services:

Multi-family recycling \$1.73 per month for bin service each bin set

Multi-family recycling \$2.12 per pickup for cart service each cart

Optional services:

Extra recycling cart \$2.12 per pickup for each cart

Multi-family recycling container service for mixed waste paper

3 cu. yd. \$14.14 per pickup for each container
4 cu. yd. \$17.98 per pickup for each container
6 cu. yd. \$24.42 per pickup for each container
8 cu. yd. \$31.69 per pickup for each container

Additional miscellaneous fees See Appendix A, H.

The above rates shall be adjusted in accordance with the modification frequency provisions of paragraph 2.3 by an amount equal to 65% of the Consumer Price Index for Urban wage Earners and Clerical Workers, all items published by the US Dept. of Labor, statistics for the Seattle-Everett Metropolitan area. This multiple shall not exceed 5 percent.

The material collected as part of the multi-family recycling service shall also be subject to the provisions of the Market Price Sharing provisions of this contract.

It is also understood that the City will compensate the Contractor for those multi-family recycling services performed prior to the date of signing this amendment which are not addressed in the provisions of paragraph 2.31.4 (Multi-Family Recycling Pilot Program).

1. SPECIAL COLLECTION SERVICES: Should a commercial customer request that collection service be performed on Saturday, the Contractor will perform said service. The City agrees to pay the Contractor for these services at a rate equal to the rates contained in Appendix A or as adjusted according to this contract plus an additional 20%.

#### IV. MISCELLANEOUS

a. REPLACEMENT AND ADDITIONAL YARD WASTE CARTS AND RECYCLING BIN SETS:

Should a customer request additional yard waste carts or recycling bins the Contractor will supply said containers. The City agrees to compensate the Contractor for the yard waste carts based on rates found in Appendix B and for the bins at a rate of \$.35 per month for each bin.

#### b. SPECIAL TRANSPORTATION CHARGE:

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2.20, the expense of hauling non putrescible waste accumulated by the Department of Public Works when transported by Contractor from the City Service Center to a qualified disposal site shall be paid to Contractor by City at the hourly rate of \$50.50 per hour.

The foregoing amendments to the contract shall become effective January 1, 1993.
