A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN A PORTION OF NE 124TH STREET

WHEREAS, the City has received a request by Robert and Laura Kinssies, File No NU-92-78, to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as part of 5th Street (known now as NE 124th Street); and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland was incorporated as a municipal corporation in 1905, and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated, and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows

<u>Section 1</u> The City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes any interest in the portions of right-of-way described as follows and as shown in Attachment 1

A portion of 5th Street as shown on the plat of Waterfront Addition to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 92, King County, Washington, Recorder's Office, and being more particularly described as follows

All of that portion of 5th Street lying between the northerly projected west line of Block 5 of said addition and the northerly projected west line of Block 6 of said addition
