## RESOLUTION R- 3829

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE DOWNTOWN KIRKLAND INTERIM PARKING PLAN.

Whereas, on July 20, 1993 the Council reviewed parking issues for downtown Kirkland for the interim period during construction of the new library; and

Whereas, the Council wishes to set forth by resolution several aspects of the interim parking plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City of Kirkland has for some years provided off-street public parking at Peter Kirk Park. The interim parking program is designed to replace the parking which will be unavailable during construction of the new library at the Peter Kirk site, estimated to be about eighteen months. The actions taken by the Council with respect to interim parking arrangements are intended to be temporary, and to be in effect only through December 31, 1994.

Section 2. The Council approves use of a portion of the Waverly site for parking during the interim period. This parking will be along the existing driveway area, with some widening, and will accommodate approximately fifty The City Manager is hereby authorized vehicles. and directed to enter into an agreement with the Kirkland Downtown Association (KDA) for KDA to provide services related to the interim parking plan. Such agreement would be the means by which the Waverly site parking is managed. would be paid a fee based on Waverly site permits sold. The agreement would also state that KDA is to provide, on private property, parking available to the public for a reasonable The agreement would include provision for payment to KDA of \$12,000 for interim parking plan services. With respect to the \$12,000.00 the City would pay to KDA, the City would be reimbursed from BIA funds, as provided in Ordinance 3378.
