

RESOLUTION R- 3853

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CONFIRMING THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO PURCHASE REAL PROPERTY FOR EXPANSION OF DAVID E. BRINK PARK.

Whereas, the City of Kirkland's adopted Comprehensive Park, Open Space, and Recreation Plan identifies the acquisition of waterfront on Lake Washington as a top priority; and

Whereas, a parcel of property immediately south of the existing David E. Brink Park, which includes 175 feet of waterfront, and is commonly known as the "Burhen Property", was proposed for acquisition in grant applications; and

Whereas, the City expects to receive \$1,200,000.00 in grant funds for the acquisition of real property to expand David E. Brink Park;


Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby confirms the City's commitment to purchase the "Burhen" real property, addressed as 723 Lake Street, for a purchase price of \$1,500,000.00.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take steps necessary to complete the purchase of the above described property. This property will be added to the City of Kirkland's David E. Brink Park.
