

RESOLUTION NO. 3876

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CANCELING CERTAIN WARRANTS OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND NOT PRESENTED TO THE CITY FOR PAYMENT WITHIN THE 60 DAY PERIOD FROM THEIR ISSUE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Administration and Finance for the City of Kirkland has advised the City Council that certain warrants of the City of Kirkland remain outstanding and have not been presented for payment within 60 days of their issue; and

WHEREAS, the warrants printed on their face, state "Void after 60 days"; and

WHEREAS, the bank account the warrants were to be paid through has been closed and the City has a different official depository; and

WHEREAS, all payees were sent letters notifying them of this impending action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The following warrants of the City of Kirkland, none of which said warrants are either registered warrants or interest-bearing warrants, and all of which are outstanding and have not been presented for payment within 60 days of their issue date, are hereby declared canceled and said warrants shall no longer be recognized by the City Treasurer for the City of Kirkland as authorized for payment of City monies.


