RESOLUTION NO. R- 3916

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN A PORTION OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 234, SUPPLEMENTARY PLAT TO KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request by Richard Radford, File No. NU-94-135, to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as part of the alley in Block 234, Supplementary Plat to Kirkland.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland was incorporated as a municipal corporation in 1905; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes any interest in the portions of right-of-way described as follows:

A portion of the alley as shown on the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 8 of Plats, page 5, King County, Washington, Recorder's Office, and being more particularly described as follows:

The northern half of the 16-foot wide right-of-way adjoining the south edge of Lot 1 and the south edge of the east 20 feet of Lot 2 of Block 234 of said addition.
