RESOLUTION R- 3948

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREETS AS REQUESTED IN FILE NO. NU-95-36.

Whereas, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as rights-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland: and

Whereas, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

Whereas, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City in 1967, with the relevant rights-of-way having been unopened; and

Whereas, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested in File No. NU-95-36, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes any interest in the portions of right-of-way described as follows: Those portions of right-of-way dedicated in the plat of Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, Page 86, Records of King County, which abut Lots 1 through 9 in Block 8 of said plat; being identified in said plat as a portion of the south one-half of Victoria Avenue (now shown as N.E. 99th Street), the east one-half of that alley which is shown adjacent to the western edge of said Lot 9, and the north one-half of that alley which is shown adjacent to the southern edge of said Lots 1 through 9.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this <u>5th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 1995.


