RESOLUTION R- 3970

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREETS AS REQUESTED.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Waterfront Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City in 1988, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes any interest in the portion of right-of-way described as follows: Portions of right-of-ways dedicated in the plat of Waterfront Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6, Page 92, Records of King County, which abut Lots 1 through 6, Block 15 of said plat; being identified in said plat as the portion of the south 30 feet of Fourth Street (now designated as NE 122nd Street) and west 30 feet of Rainier Avenue (now designated as 92nd Avenue NE) abutting Lots 1 through 6.
