## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREETS AS REQUESTED.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City in 1967, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest in the portion of right-of-way described as follows: A portion of right-of-way dedicated in the plat of Lake Avenue Adddition to Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, page 86, Records of King County, which abuts Lots 1, 2, 3, and the north half of lot 4, Block 10 of said plat; being identified in said plat as the portion of the west 8 feet of alley right-of-way abutting the east side of said lots.
