## RESOLUTION NO. 4056

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREET AS REQUESTED.

WHEREAS, the City received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Cormode and Adsit's First Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City in 1967, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest in the portions of right-of-way described as follows: A portion of right-of-way dedicated in the plat of Cormode and Adsit's First Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6, page 44, Records of King County, which abuts Lots 7 through 12, Block 29 of said plat; being identified in said plat as the portion of the west 30 feet of Pittsburgh Street (now designated as 117th Avenue NE) abutting Lot 12 and the portion of the north 30 feet of Chicago Street (now designated as NE 52nd Street) abutting Lots 7 through 12.
