## RESOLUTION NO. 4063

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINOUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREETS AS REQUESTED

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1889 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Lake Avenue's Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was incorporated into the City in 1905, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> As requested, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest except for a sanitary sewer main easement in the portion of the 98th Street right-of-way described as follows:

- The south 30 feet of NE 98th Street adjacent to Lots 7, 8 and 9;
- The north 8 feet of the alley right-of-way adjacent to the south ends of Lots 7, 8 and . 9:
- The east 8 feet of the alley right-of-way along the west side of Lot A and the two • above described areas:
- The south 8 feet of the alley along the east end of Lots 10 and 11; •
- All of Block 9 of Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, page 86, record of King County.
