

RESOLUTION NO. 40.70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF AN ALLEY IN THE 500 BLOCK BETWEEN 5TH STREET AND 6TH STREET (FILE NO. VC-97-15).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by the owners of real property representing more than two thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of the alley.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of the alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of the alley, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:


That portion of the 16-foot wide alley as attaches by law to Lots 1, through 28 inclusive, Block 97, Kirkland Terrace, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 21 of Plats, page 42, in King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in the Kirkland City Hall, 123 Fifth Avenue, on May 6, 1997, at 7:30 p.m.
