## RESOLUTION NO. R-4081

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR AN OUTDOOR RECREATION PROJECT TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION, AS PROVIDED BY THE WASHINGTON WILDLIFE RECREATION PROGRAM AND THE MARINE RECREATIONAL LAND ACT, FOR ACQUISITION OF PARK LAND ON ROSE HILL (WILLIAMSON PROPERTY) IN KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland has approved a "Comprehensive Park Open Space and Recreation Plan" for the City which identifies acquisition of community park land in the North Rose Hill neighborhood within the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Washington Wildlife Recreation Program and the Marine Recreation Land Act, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland considers it in the best public interest to acquire additional park land in the North Rose Hill neighborhood in the City of Kirkland;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding assistance.

<u>Section 2</u>. Any funding assistance so received shall be used for the acquisition of 8.9 acres of real property located adjacent to and south of North Rose Hill Woodlands Park on 124th Avenue NE.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City's share of the project will be derived from City reserve funds.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City of Kirkland does hereby certify that the City is responsible to support all non-cash commitments to the local share should they not materialize.

Section 5. Any facility developed and any property acquired with financial aid through the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation will be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.

<u>Section 6</u>. This resolution shall become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

<u>Section 7</u>. Adequate notification has been given, an opportunity provided for public input, and published notices have identified affected flood plains and/or wetlands, if applicable.

<u>Section 8</u>. The City of Kirkland hereby certifies that the City is owner of the land to be developed and, based on current knowledge, provides assurance there are no encumbrances on the land which would restrict recreational use of the land as proposed in this application.
