A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST IN UNOPENED STREETS ARE REQUESTED.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1889 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was incorporated into the City in 1905, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. As requested, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest in the portion of the alleys described as follows:

- The north 30 feet of NE 88th Street adjacent to the south lot lines of Lots 39 and 40 of Block 232
- The south 30 feet of NE 88th Street adjacent to Lot 1 of supplementary plat of Block 227
- Of the supplementary plat of Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, Page 86, Record of King County
- Said right-of-way is contained by the easterly margin of the BNSF right-of-way and the westerly margin of the 112th Avenue right-of-way.
