

RESOLUTION R - 4165

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN AN UNOPENED STREET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY MURRAY MCKINNEY.

WHEREAS, the City has received requests to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland in 1967, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. As requested by Murray McKinney, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest in the portion of right-of-way as follows:
A portion of right-of-way dedicated in the plat of Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, Volume 8, Page 5, Records of King County, which abuts Lots 13 and 14, Block 246 of said plat: being identified in said plat as the portion of the north 30 feet of NE 94 Street abutting lots 13 and 14.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this 16 day of March, 1999.
