

RESOLUTION NO. 4179

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IN THE RELOCATION OF THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE BUILDING AS AUTHORIZED BY KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.85.090.

WHEREAS, City Council has directed staff to preserve the Christian Science Church due to its historical significance; and

WHEREAS, a relocation of the Christian Science Church structure is required to escape its demolition; and

WHEREAS, the City may have suffered a substantial loss by reason of the time required for following the regular bid process; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager authorized an emergency purchase pursuant to Kirkland Municipal Code Section 3.85.090 in order to prevent such a loss;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. An emergency that could have caused the permanent loss of the historically significant Christian Science Church building existed due to the redevelopment of the properties upon which it rested.


Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take steps necessary to prevent the demolition of this building by providing payment to Lindsay Moving and Rigging Inc. for the services purchased by the City pursuant to Kirkland Municipal Code Section 3.85.090.
