

RESOLUTION R - 4194

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN UNOPENED 92nd AVENUE NE AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNERS PHILIP AND SHERRI BERGERON.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the Waterfront Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. As requested by property owners, Philip and Sherri Bergeron, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest in the portion of right-of-way as follows: A portion of unopened 92nd Avenue NE dedicated in the Waterfront Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, Page 92, Records of King County, which abuts Lots 19, 20 and the north half of Lot 18 in Block 16 of said plat: being identified in said plat as the portion of the east 30 feet of unopened 92nd Avenue NE abutting the west side of Lots 19, 20, and the north half of Lot 18.
