

**RESOLUTION NO. R-4200**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 11TH AVENUE WEST (FILE NO. VC-99-21).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by the owners of real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 11th Avenue West; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of 11th Avenue West;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of 11th Avenue West, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of 11th Avenue West lying 5.00 feet southwest of Block 30, Blewett's First Addition to Kirkland, according to the plat recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, Page 82, Records of King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at the southernmost corner of said Block 30, said point being the true point of beginning;

Thence north  $46^{\circ}24'00''$  west along the southwesterly line of said Block 30 for a distance of 193.43;

Thence south  $07^{\circ}17'13''$  east 7.93 feet to a point 5.00 feet southwesterly of the southwest line of said Block 30;

Thence south  $46^{\circ}24'00''$  east 187.28 feet to the northwesterly margin of 6th Street West;

Thence north  $34^{\circ}36'00''$  east 5.00 feet to the true point of beginning.

Containing 952 square feet more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in the Kirkland City Hall, 123 Fifth Avenue, on March 21, 2000 at 7:30 p.m.
