

RESOLUTION R- 4209

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, DESIGNATING THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGER AS ALTERNATE TO SERVE ON THE METROPOLITAN WATER POLLUTION ABATEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (MWPAAC).

WHEREAS, RCW 35.58.210 provides for each metropolitan municipal corporation, authorized to perform water pollution abatement, to establish a Metropolitan Water Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee to be composed of representatives of each component city and county within such metropolitan municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, City of Kirkland Resolution R-3557 designated the Public Works Director as the Kirkland representative to this committee and Operations and Maintenance Engineer as alternate to said committee; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland no longer has an Operations and Maintenance Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the interest of the City of Kirkland to be represented on said Metropolitan Water Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee and to have an alternate to so represent the City in the event the designated representative is unavailable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Operations and Maintenance Administrative Manager is hereby designated as the alternate of the City of Kirkland to the Metropolitan Water Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee.


