A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A LETTER WHEREBY THE CITY ELECTS TO RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN 2001.

Whereas, the City of Kirkland jointly participates with King County in applying for funds pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

Whereas, the City administration has developed and recommended to the City Council community development block grant local strategies to be utilized by the City of Kirkland as funding guidelines and for inclusion in the 2000-2003 Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan; and

Whereas, the City Council considered the recommended strategies in a public hearing and adopted the strategies by Resolution R-3928:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign a letter to King County Housing and Community Development expressing the City's election to receive and administer Community Development Block Grant Funds, a copy of which is attached to the original of the resolution and incorporated herein.

Section 2. A certified or conformed copy of this resolution with attachments shall be forwarded to the King County Housing and Community Development Program, 700 Fifth Avenue, Suite 3700, Seattle, WA 98104-5037, by no later than May 30, 2000.
