A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN UNOPENED NE 94" STREET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNER JACK SANSOLO.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the lands originally dedicated in 1891 as a street abutting a portion of the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland and in 1890 as a street abutting a portion of the Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested by property owner Jack Sansolo, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest except for a utilities easement in the portion of street described as follows:

A portion of right-of-way dedicated in the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, Volume 8 of Plats, Page 5, Records of King County, which abuts the south side of lots 8, 9, and 10, Block 246, and a portion of right-of-way dedicated in the Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland, Volume 6 of Plats, Page 86, Records of King County, which abuts the south side of lot 20 of Block 24; Except the easterly 13.24 feet thereof of said plat: being identified in said plat as the portion of the north 30 feet of NE 94th Street abutting lots 8, 9, 10, and 20.
