A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ACCEPTING FROM THE **KING COUNTY** DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION **(2) TWO SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION GRANTS** TOTALING \$55,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION GRANT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the King County Department of Transportation has made available to the City of Kirkland two grants to assist the City in synchronizing traffic signals on NE 132^{ed} Street and NE 85^{ed} Street; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of said grants to assist in the cost of said programs within the City of Kirkland is within the best interests of the City and its residents and is consistent with the City's transportation goals, policies, and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager or his delegate is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland certain agreements between the City of Kirkland and the King County Department of Transportation identified as Signal Synchronization Projects for NE 132nd Street and NE 85th Street. The City Manager or his delegate is also authorized to sign for the City all documents, certifications, and reports required to be made during the course of the signal synchronization projects.
