RESOLUTION R - 4310

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN UNOPENED ALLEY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNERS DAVID AND SHERRIE MORTS.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested by property owners David and Sherrie Morts, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest it may have, if any, in the portion of right-of-way as follows:

The south 8 feet of unopened alley which abuts lots 29 and 30, and the easterly 15 feet of lot 29, Block 234, Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, Volume 8 of Plats, Page 5, Records of King County, Washington; except portions of lots 28 and 29 deeded to King County for road under recording number 1107061.
