A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DENYING AN APPEAL BY MARTHA VANGENDEREN OF THE HEARING EXAMINER DECISION IN DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. SD-IIA-99-26

WHEREAS, 135 Lake Street Associates, L.P., filed with the Department of Planning and Community Development an application for a Process IIA permit to construct a marina and breakwater on property described in the application and located within a CBD 2 zone;
