RESOLUTION R - 4388

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE IN UNOPENED ALLEY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNERS JOHN AND MARY ELLEN ZEMLIN.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to permanently abandon any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the Supplementary Plat to Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provides that any county road which remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated; and

WHEREAS, the area which is the subject of this request was annexed to the City of Kirkland, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in this context it is in the public interest to resolve this matter by agreement,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. As requested by property owners John and Mary Ellen Zemlin, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby relinquishes all interest it may have, if any, in the portion of right-of-way as follows:

A portion of unopened alley being identified as the north 8 feet of unopened alley abutting the south boundary of lots 24, 25 and 26, Block 240, Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof recorded in volume 8 of plats, page 5, records of King County, Washington; except the east 5 feet of said lot 24.
