

RESOLUTION R- 4407

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND,
AMENDING RESOLUTION R-3792 REGARDING THE RULES OF CONDUCT FOR
KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the rules of conduct for City Council meetings do not
provide adequate time to consider Process IIA appeals and Process IIB
applications; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide for more time, when
appropriate, to consider Process IIA appeals and Process IIB applications
before making a decision;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of
Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. A new Section 26 to Resolution R-3792 is added to read as
follows:

The City Council shall consider a Process IIA appeal under
KZC Chapter 150 at one meeting, and shall vote on the
appeal at the next or a subsequent meeting, in order for the
Council to gather more information from the record and
consider the appeal; provided, that the Council, by a vote of at
least five members, may suspend this rule and consider and
vote on the appeal at the first meeting. The Council's vote (to
affirm, modify or reverse the decision of the Hearing Examiner,
or direct the Hearing Examiner to hold a rehearing) shall occur
within 60 calendar days of the date on which the letter of
appeal was filed, pursuant to KZC 150.125.


Section 2. A new Section 27 to Resolution R-3792 is added to read as
follows:

The City Council shall consider a Process IIB application under
KZC Chapter 152 at one meeting, and shall vote on the
application at the next or a subsequent meeting; provided, that
the Council, by a vote of at least five members, may suspend
this rule and consider and vote on the application at the first
meeting. The Council shall first consider the application at a
meeting held within 45 calendar days of the date of issuance
of the Hearing Examiner's recommendations, pursuant to KZC
152.90.

Section 3. Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in open
meeting this 18th day of November, 2003.
