

RESOLUTION NO. 4492

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF
HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF THE 1ST
STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY (FILE NO. VAC05-00001)

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland
signed by the owners of real property representing more than two-thirds
of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 1ST
Street.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of
Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to
consider the vacation of said portion of 1st Street right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the
City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the
public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served
by the vacation of a portion of the 1st Street right-of-way, situate in
Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:


Lot 17 and the south one-half of Lot 18, Block 109, Burke-Farrar's
Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle, Division No 27, according to
the Plat thereof recorded in Volume 21 of Plats, Page(s) 90, records of
King County, Washington

City Council in the Kirkland City Hall, 123 Fifth
Avenue, on April 19, 2005 at 7:30 pm.
